Twenty new tees were added, and over 25 new bunkers were strategically placed. We even rerouted three entire holes to take advantage of the terrain and maximize player enjoyment. The result is a playable jewel of a course, which, although not long, at 6,626 yards, is all the challenge you want; bringing every club in your bag in to play!

Our excellent topography offers sweeping views of Eagle Mountain Lake, for most of the course and from our beautiful poolside terrace. There you can enjoy a cold beverage, bistro style food and pleasant service before or after your round.
